



Each kit includes 6-7 beads as well as a NeckArt Baggie.



NeckArt baggies include the following in each kit  
*Note: Kits includes either all small or both large and small bead caps depending on kit.*



Tools needed, Round and flat nose pliers, wire cutters



Step one: thread a *SMALL* bead cap onto one headpin



Thread bead onto headpin after small bead cap



Thread large or small bead cap onto headpin on top of bead then use round nose pliers and grasp headpin right at the top of the bead/cap.



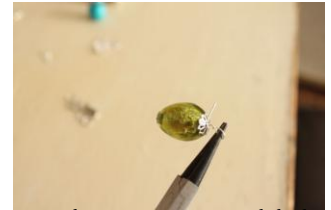
Bend headpin to a 45 degree angle.



Re-grasp headpin using the round nose pliers right past your bend



Now bend the wire *BACK* around the pliers, to create a loop



Wrap the excess wire around the bottom of the loop. Cut off excess with wire cutters. Do this for each bead in your pack.



Hold Chain with Flat nose pliers and open where the break is.



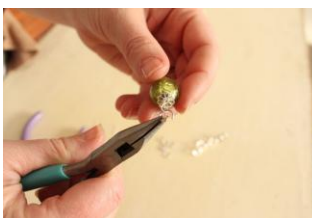
Thread the lobster clasp onto the chain opening.



Reclose the chain and it should look like this.



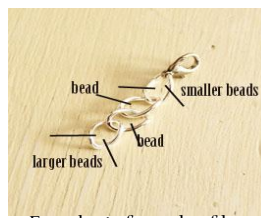
Open a jump ring using your fingers and flat nose pliers



Thread a bead onto the jump ring. Do not close



Thread bead and jump ring onto one of the chain sections, then close jump ring.



For a basic formula of how to lay your NeckArt. Use the diagram above. Two large beads on bottom chain, 2 small beads on top chain, and one in each middle chain. Alternating Colors on each side. Once done attach to Necklace using Lobster Clasp!
